Specific Terms and Conditions for your Amber Blue Saver Account

These Amber Blue Saver Account Specific Terms and Conditions must be read in conjunction with the Society's General Terms and Conditions. If there is a conflict between these Amber Blue Saver Account Specific Terms and Conditions and the Society's General Terms and Conditions, these Amber Blue Saver Account Specific Terms and Conditions will apply.

1. Opening and operating your account

- 1.1. The minimum opening balance in the Amber Blue Saver Account is £100 (adults) or £25 (under 16s); the minimum operating balance is £1.
- 1.2. A cash payment equal to 0.25 per cent of the total average balance held in all Amber Blue Saver Accounts during the previous financial year will be paid to Shrewsbury Town Football Club annually on 1 April. For example, if the total average balance held in all Amber Blue Saver Accounts is £1 million, the bonus payment to Shrewsbury Town Football Club will be calculated as follows:
 £1 million x 0.25% = £2,500.
- 1.3. The initial deposit of at least the opening balance must be made within 30 days of the account being opened, or we will automatically close the account.
- 1.4. The Society reserves the right to vary the Terms and Conditions (including the rate of bonus paid to Shrewsbury Town Football Club and/or the manner in which it is calculated) upon giving notice.

2. Interest

2.1. Interest is variable and paid annually on 1 April.

3. Withdrawing money from your account

- 3.1. Withdrawals (or account closure) from a branch account are made using a passbook in one of our branches.
- 3.2. Withdrawals from a branch account can also be made by electronic transfer and will only be paid in sterling by electronic payment to your nominated bank account held in the same name as the account from which the withdrawal/closure is to be made.
